TOURS

Ozark Folk Center 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Wed, Aug.30 (\$80.00).

Nestled in Mountain View, Arkansas, a town dubbed Folk Music Capital of the World, is the Ozark Folk Center State Park. An American cultural treasure, this is the only park dedicated to the perpetuation and interpretation of the heritage of the Ozark region. Here in Mountain View, the Ozark Folk Center connects you to the music, dance, crafts, and lore that have been passed from generation to generation since settlers first made these rugged, scenic hills home. Hear live performances of traditional Southern mountain music by talented musicians--the pure unplugged sounds of the fiddle, banjo, mandolin, mountain dulcimer, autoharp, and acoustic guitar. See artisans demonstrate over 20 homestead skills and pioneer crafts. The Ozark Folk Center Crafts Village has artisans demonstrating folk art crafts and the everyday skills used by Ozark Mountain people in the 19th and early 20th centuries. These skills have become Arkansas heritage crafts - basket weaving, broom making, blacksmithing, pottery making, knife making, weaving, quilting, wood carving, soap making, dress making, herb gardening, coopering, doll making, candle making, wood turning, and more.

Hot Springs Riverboat Cruise 9:00 am to 4:00 pm, Thur, Aug 31 (\$80.00)

Sit back and relax aboard the Belle, a 250 passenger riverboat, and enjoy the captain's narration as he unfolds secrets of America's "Spa City." His entertaining tour includes million dollar mansions, natural islands, quaint resorts, panoramic views of the Ouachita Mountains, colorful anecdotes, humorous stories, and well researched historical information. Tour also includes a land tour of the oldest park in the National Park System, stories about Hot Springs date back 10,000 years. Known as "The Valley of the Vapors" and "The Spa City", water gushes from the mountainside at a constant 143' degrees. Relaxing, medicinal, and revitalizing... this resort town in the Ouachita Mountains has lured American Indian Tribes, gangsters Al Capone and Bugs Moran, and millions of visitors to enjoy shopping, art galleries, museums, and world famous "Bathhouse Row." Also known as Bill Clinton's boyhood town, you'll see the former president's home and favorite hangouts...and hear stories you won't find anywhere else!

Garvin Woodland Gardens/Hot Springs Nat. Park 8:30 am to 2:30 pm Fri, Sept 01, (\$50.00)

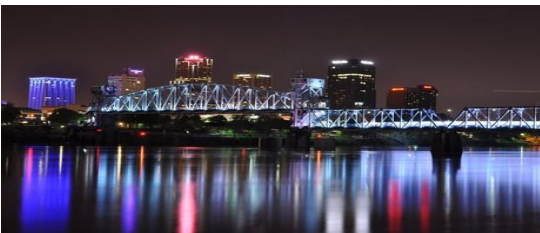
